**New business for 2009-2010 Tournament:**

Tournament matches will start at 8 am on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. (Board will make sure Dean has someone there to start at 8 am.

Cash payouts will only be given out at certain times. 2 board members will be checking the dollar amount.

Board will be bringing in an Amplifier to Olympia for the Calcutta so everyone can hear what is going on. Some tables near the check in area will be freed up during Calcutta so players will not be bothered by all the people standing around.

All phone calls with questions about the tournament should be forwarded to Rob. Rob will then mark down the call, date it and email pertinent information to everyone so all board members are on the same page about question. This way no one will say so and so told me I could do this at the tournament without everyone else knowing about it.

This year we will have certain tables set up as “feature tables” for highly popular matches. They will have a little more room around them to accommodate more people watching the match without bothering other matches going on.

All entries should be submitted through the league operators once again.

Board has decided to do a door prize draw for early bird entries instead of T-Shirts. Possible items to include – Hotel vouchers, lunch/dinner vouchers, etc.
