National BCA moving National Tournament to the RIO Hotel in Vegas and moving the tournament date to July in 2013

The following disclaimer will be added to the WIBCA website and entry forms starting today.
“WIBCAPL may use my photograph, image, likeness, or name for information, reporting or promotional purposes via print, video and other media.

All names currently on the website will remain on the website.

State Tournament Qualifications – (Will be posted on the website)
4 weeks of Wisconsin League play, starting 06/01/12 it will change to 6 weeks of Wisconsin League play. Players outside of Wisconsin will be required to play 8 weeks in a Wisconsin League. Pat Motioned, Ron 2nd. Passed Unanimously.

Core Players – A and B Divisions need 2 core players (Same team/same league). Other players can come from any WI BCA league or team.

Definition of advancement of players at WIBCA State Tournament:

Teams –

With 4 A's and 1 AA, the 4 A's would advance; if 5 A's, all advance
With 4 B's and 1 A, the 4 B's would advance; if 5 B's, all advance

Singles –

B Division – 50% of the paid field will advance 1 level
A and AA Division – 25% of the paid field will advance 1 level

Allison Fischer – Will try to get again for the 2012 State Tournament. Price should be similar to 2011. Dean will get in contact with Allison.

Dress Code – All violations of dress code must be reported by opponent/s before a match begins, once match begins, it will not be considered a foul. Referees will try to scan the room for violations before matches begin.

*No torn jeans of any kind are allowed, this includes fashionably ripped jeans.

The WIBCAPL Face Book page is working well for spreading the word on upcoming WIBCA events.

Things to work on for the next year:

1. Possibly being able to submit entry blanks on line for State Tournament. Paying with Credit Cards.
2. Dean checking on smoking tent/area for next year.
3. Rob getting name tags for new board member for next year.

Criteria for petitioning to move down after being bumped up:

*If moved up by team, must play singles at least 1 year, then can petition to be moved down.

*If moved up by singles, must play singles at least 2 years, then can petition to be moved down.

**It is not guaranteed that players will get moved down after above play times, players must fill out rating request form on the website and the WIBCACL Board will discuss it.

WIBCACL Board is considering new venues for the year 2013. Will check Green Bay.

WIBCACL will create a questionnaire for players at the State Tournament to see if players favor going back to 2 separate weekends for the Singles and Team events.
