

WI BCA Board meeting

September 17, 2006

It was decided to go with 72 tables for the singles event and 64 for the team event.

Singles 9 Ball Events:

Men's B Div will be by itself. Race to 5 on the winners/loser.

Men's AA/A Div will be combined. AA div race to 7 on the winner/loser. A race to 6 on the winner/loser.

Master's Div race to 8 on both the winners/loser.

Woman's 9 Ball will be the same as last year. Master 6, A to 5, B to 4.

Singles 8 Ball Event:

Men's B Div race to 4 winner/3 loser. This Division will be limited to the first 256 entries.

Men's A Div race to 5 winner/4 loser.

Men's AA Div race to 6 winner/loser.

Men's Master Div race to 7 winner/loser.

Woman B Div race to 4 winner/3 loser.

Woman A Div race to 5 winner/4 loser.

Woman Master Div race to 6 winner/loser.

Team 8 Ball.

Men's Master/AA Div will be handicapped the same as last year. The difference will be that this year we will be playing in a round robin bracket with at least 4-5 teams per bracket. The top 2 teams will move on to a bracket play chart. Depending on how many entries we have it will be to either an 8 team chart with double elimination or 16 teams single elimination.

Woman's Master/A Div Div will be handicapped the same as last year. The difference will be that this year we will be playing in a round robin bracket. The top 2 teams will move on to a bracket play chart. Depending on how many entries we have it will be to either a 4 or 8 team chart with double elimination.

Bump ups: First and second place teams in the Men's B division, Men's A division and Women's B division will move up all players to the next division. Anyone feeling that they were unfairly bumped may appeal with the form found on this page.

It should be stressed that the men's B division is for entry level tournament players to low intermediate players with not much tournament experience. The B division is not a division you enter just because you have never played in BCA before. League operators should place players according to ability, if it is their first year in the BCA.

Deadline for entries were discussed and will be posted on the site along with the entry forms.
